### **FOREWORD**

### **STAFF**

### **ACADEMIC ACHIEVEMENTS AISSE/AISSCE 2021**

We believe that academics should be the major focus of a school. The excellent results of the board examination (batch 2020-21) of Class X and XII have brought laurels to the school. We secured 100% result in AISSCE 2021 and AISSE 2021 with more than 90% of students receiving first-class. This was made possible by the tireless efforts of our secondary and senior secondary teachers.

### **ONLINE STUDY DURING COVID 19**

Following the COVID-19 pandemic, there has been a surge in interest in online education. As a result, education has changed dramatically, with the distinctive rise of e-learning, whereby teaching is undertaken remotely and on digital platforms.

At BenchMark, teachers and coordinators were regularly in contact with the students and parents and conducted online classes regularly. The online academic class began on 01st June 2021, via Google Meet. Apart from that, Google Classrooms were set up for each class, where teachers and students could share their activities.

The school continues to incorporate creativity, innovations and the latest practices in the field of pedagogy.

### **ONLINE EXAMINATION**

All the exams conducted at the school followed the board pattern. Periodical assessments and examinations were conducted in pen paper Mode and Google Form mode in the respective classrooms under the supervision of teachers. Subject enrichment activities were done by the students and teachers evaluate those as the internal assessment. Submission of answer sheets in school by parents was notable. Mark sheets were prepared by teachers and progress reports were generated and distributed to the parents. Class-wise open house meetings were held at the end of the year, in addition to regular online meetings led by the Principal, HMs and class teachers.

### SCHOOL CABINET ELECTION

The school cabinet election was held online, and the Investiture Ceremony was held in a fitting manner, with responsibilities assigned to all elected students in order to develop a sense of leadership.

### **CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES**

Students from all classes participated in various events like storytelling, poem recitation, script writing, blog writing and hand writing competitions, live reporting, be the character, versification, anchoring, product launch and news reading.

Art Integrated Learning has been a component of the school even before the CBSE mandated it as compulsory. Various activities related to the subject wereheld on a regular basis.

### **CELEBRATIONS**

Celebrations instill students and teachers with unparalleled enthusiasm and excitement. They also help to foster national integration, international understanding, religious and cultural awareness. BenchMark celebrated the national, religious, and cultural festivals and occasions with pomp and grandeur.

### PARENT ORIENTATION PROGRAMME
