The above sanction is subject to the fulfilments of the following conditions namely:-

- The School shall abide by the Provisions of Right of children to Free and Compulsory Education Act, 2009 and the Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Rules, 2011.
- 2. The School shall admit in Class 1( or in Pre Primary class, as the case may be ), to the extent of at least 25% of the strength of that class, children belonging to weaker section and disadvantaged group in the neighbourhood and provide free and compulsory elementary education till its completion.

  - iii. No child is required to pass any Board Examination till the completion of elementary education;
  - iv. Every child completing elementary education shall be awarded a certificate as laid down in rule 21.
  - v. Inclusion of students with disabilities/special needs as per provisions of the Act.
  - vi. The teachers are recruited with the minimum qualifications as laid down under sub-section(1) of section 23 of the Act.
  - vii. The teachers perform their duties specified under sub-section(1) of section 24 of the Act and those under the rules issued thereunder.
  - viii. The teacher shall not engage himself or herself in non-educational and private teaching activities otherwise than permitted under the Act.
- The school shall follow the syllabus on the basis of curriculum laid down by State Government/Educational Authority.
- 7. The school shall maintain the standards and norms of the school as specified in section 19 of the Act and the Rules issued thereunder and the facilities reported at the time of inspection i.e. on 15.03.2023 are as given under:-

8. No unrecognized classes shall run within the premises of the school or outside in the

same name of the school.

9. The school buildings or other structures or the grounds are used only for the purpose of education and skill development.

- 10. The school is run by a society registered under the Societies Registration Act, 1860 (21 of 1860), or a public trust or an educational agency constituted under any law for the time being in force.
- 11. The school is not run for profit to any individual, group or association of individuals or any other persons.
- 12. The accounts shall be audited and certified by a Chartered Accountant and proper accounts statements shall be prepared as per rules. A copy each of the statement of Accounts shall be sent to the concerned Educational Officer every year.
- 13. The school furnishes such reports and information as may be required by the concerned Educational Officer from time to time and complies with such instructions of the Government to secure the continued fulfilment of the condition of recognition or the removal of deficiencies in working of the school.
